NPC: Northchurch Parish Council objects due to the pedestrian safety issues which were identified in the Road Safety Audit Stage-1-3869 by M&S Traffic Ltd which was attached to the original planning application in 2017:

- Inadequate visibility splays on either side of the shared pedestrian and vehicle access:
- Insufficient swept path information showing how large vehicles turning into the entrance will avoid striking pedestrians using the same entrance;
- Lack of footway connectivity may compromise pedestrian safety.

The report concluded that "A footway link should be provided to the footway on the NE side of the High St carriageway".

If a footway link cannot be provided, an alternative solution must be proposed which ensures safe and satisfactory means of access for pedestrians in accordance with Policy CS12 of the Dacorum Core Strategy (2013). The current implementation does not.

We also note that hedges have been planted in the front gardens next to the boundary with the High St. These will grow towards the carriageway and further reduce the visibility of pedestrians leaving the development. How will these hedges be maintained safely when there is no footway between the boundary and the High St carriageway?
