Enforcement Appeal: Land Adjacent To The Old Brickworks

Spring Garden Lane

Northchurch

Mr A Kane has appealed to the Secretary of State against the enforcement notice issued by the council concerning:-

Clearing land/excavations inc just off the public ROW

However, the notice will not take effect until the appeal has been determined and only if the decision is to dismiss the appeal.

Mr A Kane has appealed on the grounds:

Ground A That planning permission should be granted for what is alleged in the notice.

Ground G The time given to comply with the notice is too short.

These are grounds from the Section 174(2) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (As Amended).

It will be open to the Secretary of State to grant planning permission.

This appeal is being dealt with by an exchange of written statements between Mr A Kane and the Council and will be decided by an Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State.
